New Wednesday Night Team Game

Due to the popularity and positive comments on the CNTC Master/Non-Master team game held Nov. 23, the Board of Directors has decided to try this type of game on a regular basis. Starting Wednesday, January 11 and continuing the second Wednesday of each month, the Wednesday game

will be a Master/Non-Master Team Game where a Non-Master is defined as a player having fewer than 200mpts. Every team must contain at least two "Non-Master" players and any Master player on the team must have a non-Master partner.

Subject: a cancellation and a clarification

The cancellation is simple. Due to the Rider home game on August 12th, the Friday Evening game has been cancelled for that day only. The Friday Afternoon game will still be played as usual.

The clarification is more complex. Please see the Board of Director's note below. It really only applies to you if you have less than 1000 points.

Masterpoints & Game Eligibility

RDBC Policy

PLEASE NOTE as of July 21, 2011:

For all masterpoint restrictions at the club - we use the total in the club computer as the indicator for deciding who can play in the following restricted games:

Monday evening - under 100 MP

Wednesday evening - 1 player must be under 100 MP

Thursday afternoon - under 1000 MP

"8 is Enough" - The number a player is, a one (0-300), a two (301-750) or a three (751 and up).

For all Non-LM games (Tuesday afternoon and Friday evening) players become ineligible to play once they receive confirmation from the ACBL that they have achieved Life Master Status. Therefore we wait until the person gets ACBL notification of Life Master Status since the club computer doesn't give us colour of masterpoints to determine ACBL rank.

It is the responsibility of the bridge player, not the club, to know the number of points he/she has, and which games he/she qualifies to play in. If a player is unsure of their point count and eligibility it will be their responsibility to ask the Director to check the club computer and determine eligibility prior to play. If a player plays in a game they are not eligible to play in and it is brought to the Club's attention, that player and their partner or team will be marked "Not Eligible" and the points will be forfeited.
