Subject: GAME CHANGES effective July 1st

Hello everyone,

At our April Board meeting, we discussed suggestions put before us for some changes to various games, in the interest of addressing table counts and for the convenience of our members. After studying the suggestions we received, and discussing at length the rationale and data presented to us, the following decisions were made. Our Club Manager now has the sanctions in place, and the following GAME CHANGES will take effect on JULY 1, 2013

THURSDAY AFTERNOON GAME

Change from stratified under 1000 to stratified under 1500

(Although this increase does not affect many of our members, it allows for a little more latitude for those currently just over 1000 who have been supporting this game, and yet it still keeps this as a restricted game to encourage those with fewer points to continue to play or to join in)

THURSDAY EVENING GAME

Until further notice, all Thursday evening games will be cancelled, beginning July 1st and at least through August 31st, 2013. Decision regarding the future of this game will be made at the AGM on June 27th, 2013

(This game has been poorly attended, to the point of needing to be cancelled on several occasions. We have made this decision in order to be fair to the players and to the game director).

NOTE: Thurs evening N/A Pairs Qualifying game scheduled for July 4 will be switched to Tuesday evening July 2

FRIDAY EVENING GAME

Change from Non-life master to stratified under 1000 (This game has seen quite a drop in attendance. We have many players who with this change would now qualify to play. It is hoped that opening it to more of our players, while still keeping it as a restricted game, will encourage more participation)

SATURDAY 8-IS-ENOUGH

Change point designations of players designated as 2's or 3's

Point designations will now be as follows: under 300 = 1; under 1000 = 2; over 1000 = 3

(It was felt that moving the "3" designation from 750 to 1000 makes for a fairer cut-off point, and provides for more latitude in setting up teams)

Your Board will continue to monitor these and other games on a ongoing basis.
