FYI:

Bidding Box Usage - Stop Card

Concerns have been raised about proper usage of this card. Please remember the following:

- If you choose to use a Stop card, you must use it consistently, that is every time you make a skip bid
- Place the Stop card so that LHO sees it (the skip bidder is responsible for gaining LHO's attention)
- The skip bid is made. The Stop card is replaced in the bidding box
- It is each player's responsibility to maintain appropriate tempo, including after a skip bid
- When RHO has announced a skip bid, the player following the skip bidder must wait a suitable interval (about 10 seconds)
- In waiting, the player's manner must be one that suggests he is an active participant in the auction (eg. studying his hand during the pause)
- If there is a concern that proper procedure has not been followed by your opponent, it is your prerogative, should you so wish, to politely call the Director and explain the situation . The Director's

explanation and decision will always end the matter. There is zero tolerance for argumentative behaviour from either side towards each other or towards the Director..

Please note that the ACBL Bidding Box Regulations are posted on our bulletin board. If you have concerns at any time about players who are not following these regulations or about any other matter at the table, politely calling the Director is the correct approach to take. Let's all continue to enjoy the game.
